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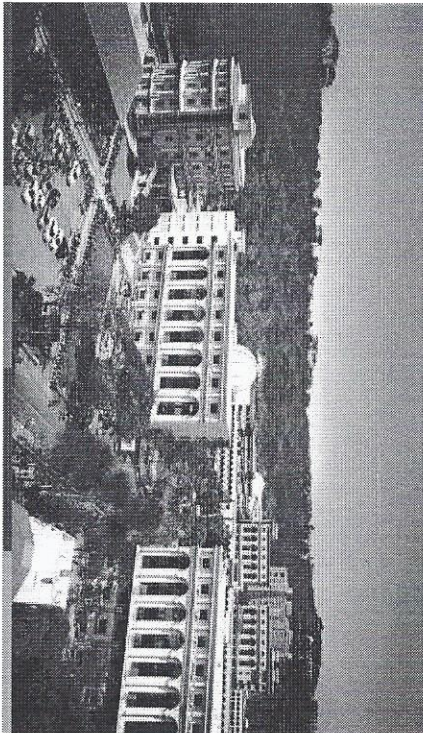
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About Us

Guidelines for Submission of Papers:

- The paper should have a separate cover page bearing only Title of the paper and author's name, designation, official address, phone number and email address.
- Length of the paper must not exceed 10 pages (including all tables, appendices and references).
- Submitted papers must NOT have been previously presented, published, accepted for publication, and under review. Please note that the institute has a strict anti-plagiarism policy so originality of the work should be ensured by the authors.

- The entire paper (title, abstract, keywords, main text, figures, tables, references, must be in ONE document created in BOTH MS-Word and PDF format. All the pages of the paper must be numbered.
- Use Times New Roman, 12-pitch font, single spaced, and 1-inch (2.5 cm) margin around. All tables must be consecutively numbered using Arabic numerals appropriate titles.
- Footnotes should be listed consecutively in the text. References should be provided using American Psychological Association (APA) Style-Sheet.
- Changes in the paper title, abstract, authorship, and actual paper would not be possible after the submission deadline.
- Make sure that the paper prints correctly (i.e. all imported figures and tables are there), and ensure that the files are virus-free.
- Post graduate students may attend the conference and may be the co-authors of papers but the papers shall be presented by the faculty or corporate professional.
- Submission of a paper implies that should the paper be accepted at least one of authors will register and present the paper in the conference.
- The manuscripts will be subject to the peer-review process.

Conference Publications

The peer-reviewed full conference papers will be published in the Book bearing International Standard Book Number (ISBN)-978-93-9254-004-4. The Abstract will be incorporated in the Conference Proceedings.
