Guidelines for the Submission of Papers

All honorable authors are kindly encouraged to contribute to and help shape the conference through submissions of their research abstracts, papers and best-practices. Also, high quality research contributions describing original and unpublished results of conceptual, constructive, empirical, experimental, or theoretical work in all areas of Children & Family dynamics are cordially invited for presentation at the conference. The conference solicits contributions of abstracts, papers and photo-essays that address themes and topics of the conference, including figures, tables and references of novel research material.

Oral Presentations:

1. Each lead presenter is requested to make a 10-minute presentation of their research. Another 5 minutes will be reserved for questions and clarifications from the audience. Papers maybe in a form of research or a documentation of best-practices along child and family program and interventions. Preference will be given to evidence-based researches and papers/documentations.
2. All the submitted papers in these proceedings will be peer reviewed by at least two reviewers drawn from the chairs of committees depending on the subject matter and the relevance of the topic to the conference. Review and initial selection will be undertaken electronically. Notification of acceptance will be sent electronically on or before 30 July 2016.

5. Interested presenters should download the official submission form online or the form attached herewith and submits the same via email to iccfphil2015@gmail.com.
6. All accepted research abstracts will be included in the Conference Book which will be given to all attendees and presenters.

7. Best Research Paper will be chosen and awarded during the closing program of the conference.

Abstract Guidelines:

- All abstract should be written in English
- The main body of the abstract should contain no more than 500 words
- When submitting an abstract, please include: - an introductory statement that outlines the background and significance of the study - a succinct description of the basic methodologies - a clear indication of the major findings of the study - a concluding statement
 - Please be guided as well on the following abstract review criteria:
 - o the conference topics - Significance of the scientific question(s) and results –
 - o Style - Organization (e.g., the abstract has a clear beginning, middle and end) –
 - o Clear question or hypothesis –
 - o Sufficient background - The experimental approach and rationale for the approach are clear
 - o The results are clearly presented –
 - o The interpretation and conclusions are reasonable and logical

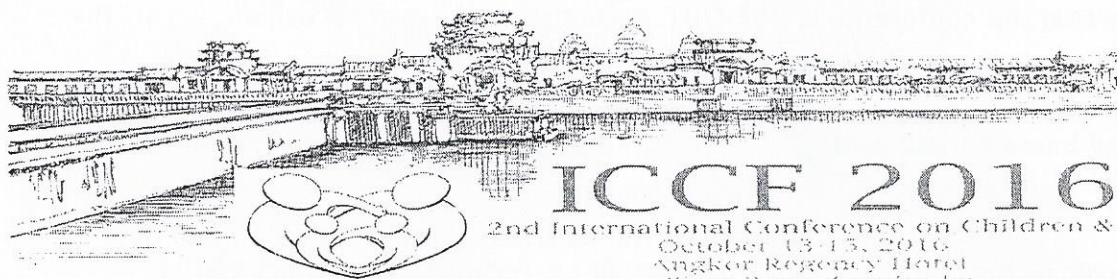
